The official origins of war

Historical Conflicts:

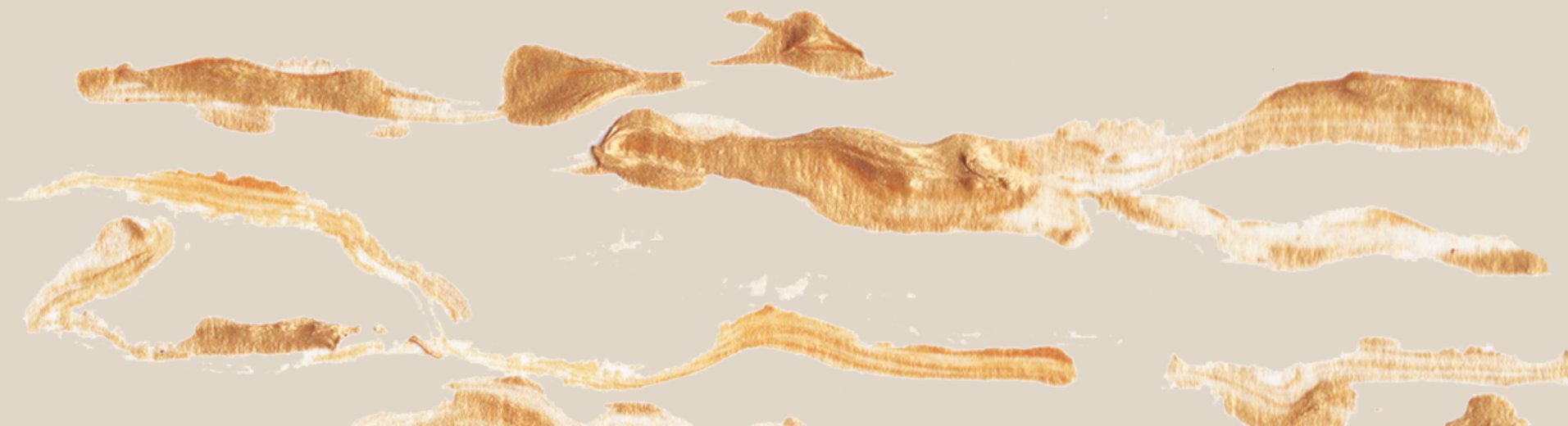
Wars have been a recurring feature of human history, dating back thousands of years.

Human Nature:

Some argue that the origins of war can be traced to inherent aspects of human nature.

Societal Factors:

Societies and their structures can play a role in the origins of war (competition for resources, territorial disputes, power struggles, and ideological differences)





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Political and Economic Factors:

Political ambitions, economic interests, and the pursuit of power have frequently been catalysts for war. (Rivalries between nations, expansionist policies, strategic resources)

International Relations:

The dynamics of international relations, including alliances, rivalries, and the balance of power, have shaped the origins of war.

Cultural and Ethnic Factors:


Cultural, ethnic, and religious differences have often played a role in the origins of war.






But in reality:

The true nature of wars stems not from the collective but from traumatized individuals, mostly males, of the political or economic elite equipped with arms.

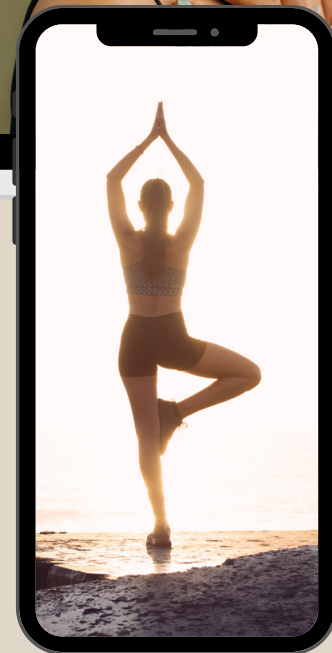

The official origins of peace

Free trade and interdependence:

A central idea of classical liberalism was that free trade promotes peace.

Democratic peace theory:

Democratic peace theory states that democracy promotes peace because of the accountability, institutions, values and norms of democratic countries.

Territorial peace theory:

Territorial peace theory argues that peace prevails when justice exists and a community has non-violent ways to resolve its differences. Peace is also achieved when human rights exist and social justice is the norm.



The official origins of love

Biological Perspective:

From a biological standpoint, love can be attributed to the human brain and its chemical processes. (dopamine, oxytocin, and serotonin, ect)

Evolutionary Perspective:

Suggests that love, particularly romantic love and pair bonding, has developed as a mechanism to ensure the survival and reproduction of our species.

Psychological Perspective:

focusing on emotions, attachment styles, and interpersonal dynamics.


Sociocultural Perspective:

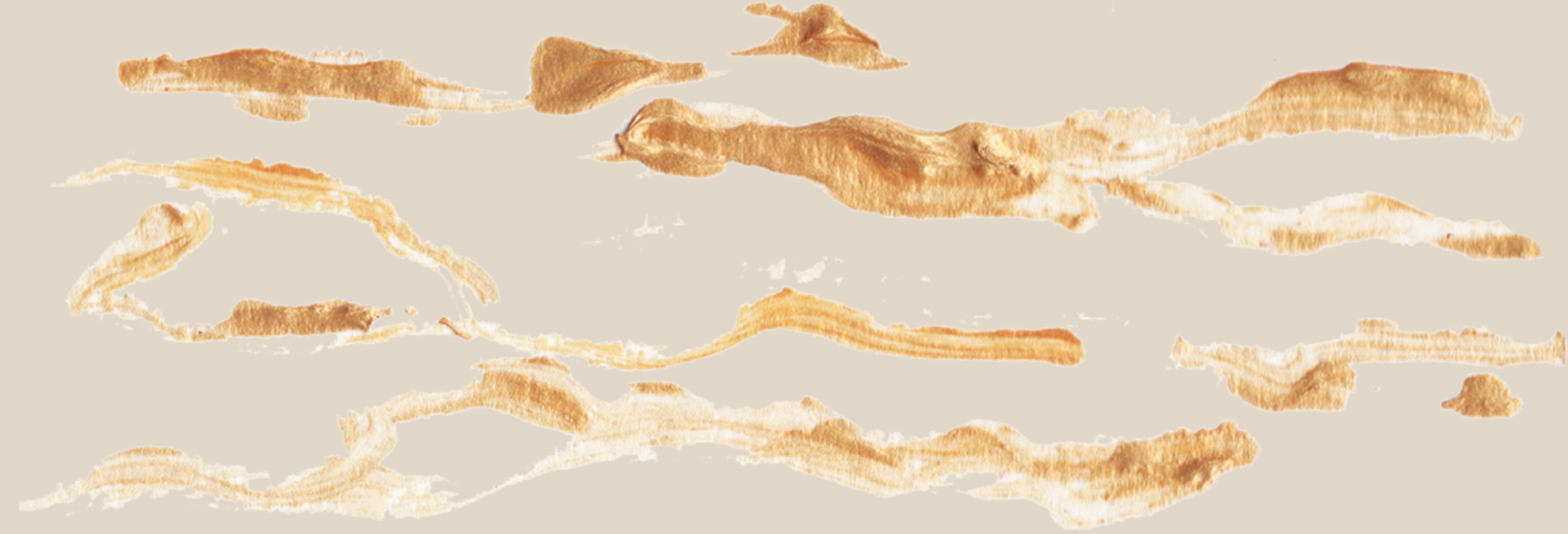
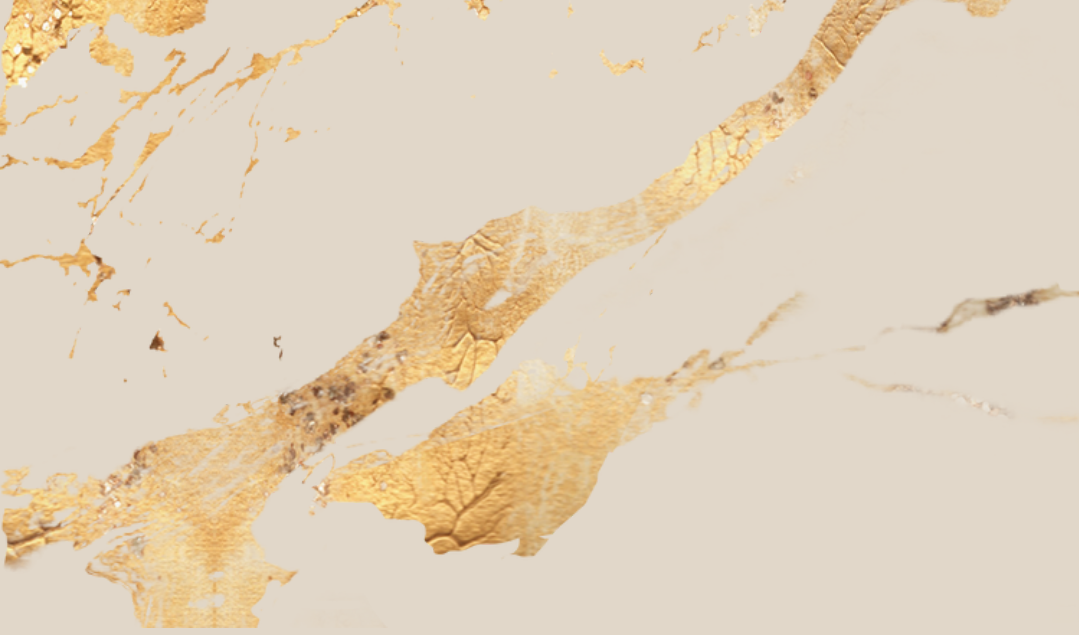
Influenced by sociocultural factors, including social norms, cultural beliefs, and societal expectations.



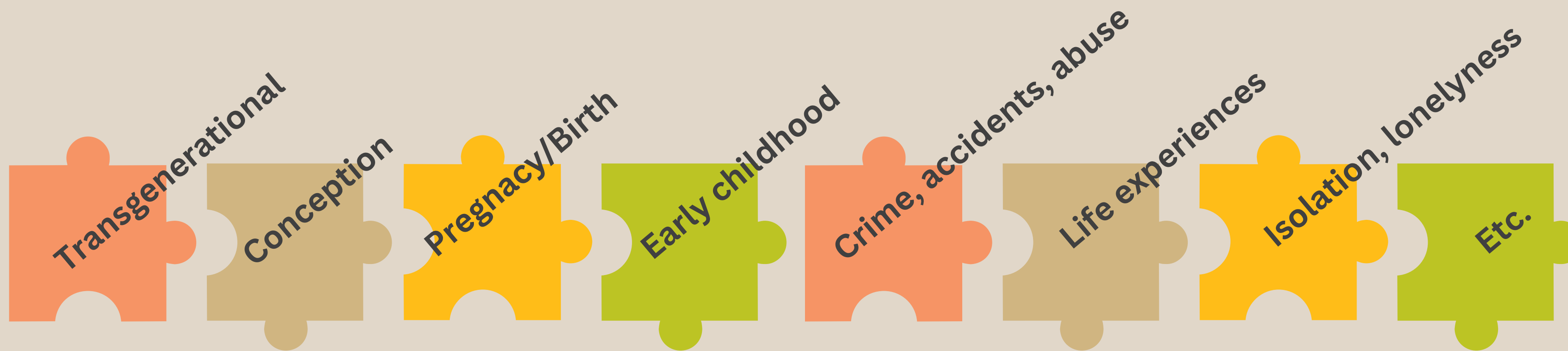

plants, animals, humans.....





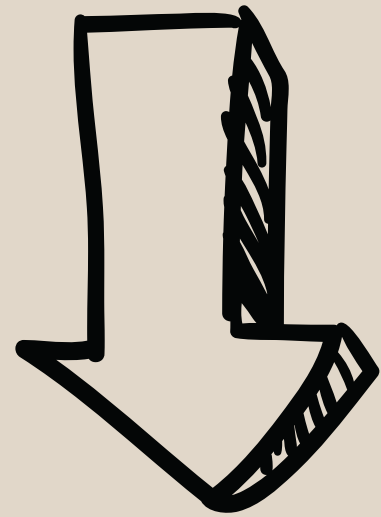

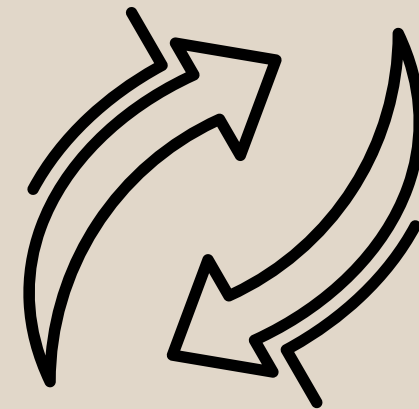
Main aim in educating humans:
